<p>\$14,400</p>	<p>Étude de mise en réseau des infrastructures de transport [Study of transport infrastructures networking] By: Cree Nation Government</p> <p>Since the launch of a regional bus service from Chisasibi to Matagami and further in Abitibi, the Cree Nation Government has been exploring opportunities to expand coverage of the transportation system. The project is to conduct a feasibility study of a shuttle service linking coastal communities and the James Bay Highway and to identify business opportunities that could emerge from the new service.</p>	<p>2017-2019</p>
<p>\$40,000</p>	<p>Projet pilote d'incubateur pour le développement d'entreprises et de l'employabilité [Pilot incubator project for business development and employability] Par : Gouvernement de la nation crie</p> <p>The project involves developing and setting up a centre for entrepreneurship and employability in Chisasibi. Inspired by digital and industrial incubators, this pilot project will test a talent incubator and business development model for the Cree Nation. This model could then be replicated in each community in Eeyou Istchee.</p>	<p>2017-2019</p>
<p>\$40,000</p>	<p>Recensement des camionneurs artisans et plan stratégique pour une association régionale [Census of independent truckers and strategic plan for a regional association] By: Cree Nation Government</p> <p>The project aims to identify independent truckers in each Cree community and establish a strategy for the creation of a regional association (sub-station) to represent them.</p>	<p>2017-2019</p>
<p>\$25,600</p>	<p>Plan de développement de serres et du secteur de l'agroalimentaire [Greenhouse development plan and the agri-food sector] By: Cree Nation Government</p> <p>Several Cree communities in Eeyou Istchee have developed greenhouses and community gardens or are preparing to do so. These projects fit perfectly into one of the objectives of the Cree Nation Government: to move toward food sovereignty and autonomy. The project aims to fund a study to explore the business development potential of these initiatives and networking among communities.</p>	<p>2017-2019</p>
